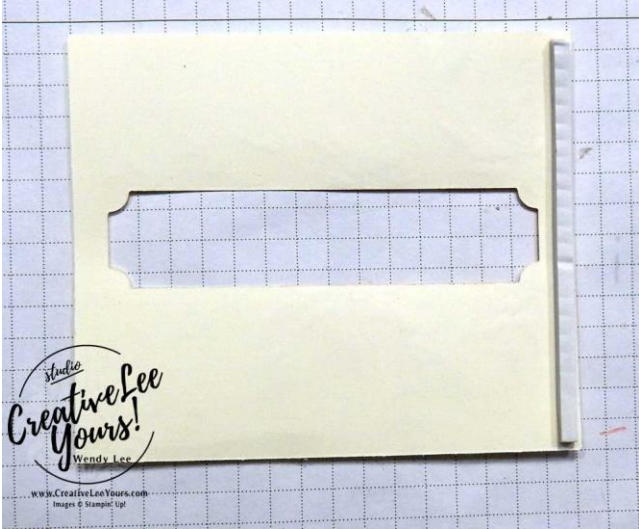


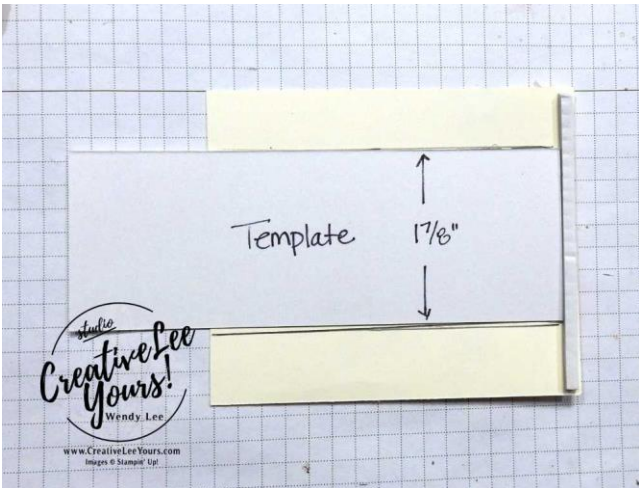
Pull Tab Instructions

Before creating the pull tab layers, I recommend having all your pieces stamped before assembling the pull tab layers. It is important to complete your stamping on the card front inside the pull tab window prior to pull tab assembly.



Once the opening is cut out and all stamping is completed on the front side of the card layer, flip it over and apply the foam adhesive strip along the far right edge of the back of the layer.

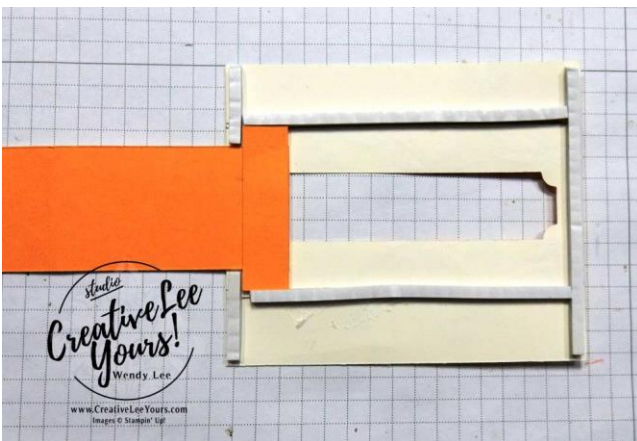


Place the completed pull tab layer so it is centered over the cut out and mark the top and bottom edge on the back of the cut out layer with a pencil. Remove the pull tab layer.

Place the template against the foam tape and draw lines along the top and bottom of the template to use as a guide.



Apply the foam adhesive tape along the pencil lines stopping short of the other side. The goal is to place the tape so it is close to the widest point of the pull tab along the horizontal lines to allow it to easily slide, but not allow too much wiggle room to prevent twisting.



Place the pull tab between the foam tape strips and slide the tab open.

Add small strips of foam adhesive along the far left edge of the layer to create a stop for the tab. Be sure the foam tape stops to allow the narrow portion of the pull tab to slide.

Apply the layer with the pull tab in place to the card front.
