


# Double Slider

Score the 5 1/2"x11" real red cardstock at 3 1/2", 7 1/8" and 10 5/8".



Punch a half circle along the top edge centered between the 3 1/2" & 7 1/8" score lines and again between the 7 1/8" & 10 5/8" score lines.

Stamp center panel as desired. This will be the outside front of the card.



Flip the cardstock over.

Wrap the 1 1/2" strip of the plastic grocery bag around the first panel. Be sure to leave a bit of slack so the bag slides easily.



Trim away any excess bag (sticking out past tape) so it doesn't get caught up when sliding.



Add tear & tape along the bottom edge of the bag with the cardstock flat.

If you want a bit more security add 2 strips of tear and tape (the pic only shows 1 strip).



Peel off the backing of the tape and adhere one of the 5 1/2" x 3 1/4" pieces of crumbcake cardstock to the bag. Make sure the cardstock is centered left to right and aligned at the top and bottom.



Close the panel and add tear & tape along the top edge of the bag.

If you want a bit more security add 2 strips of tear and tape (the pic only shows 1 strip).




Peel off the backing of the tape and adhere the second 5 1/2" x 3 1/4" piece of crumbcake cardstock to the bag. Make sure the cardstock is centered left to right and aligned at the top and bottom.



Flip the cardstock over.

Add tear & tape along the far right tab.



Peel the backing off the tape and fold the card closed make sure the crumbcake cardstock is inside the pouch.

Pull the crumbcake cardstock to check to be sure your slider works. You can now decorate your slider panels.
