Pop Up Blooms



Project Recipe:



1. Cut 4" x 4" square



2. Fold square in half diagonally.



3. Fold in half diagonally again.



4. Fold in half diagonally one last time.



5. Using the 2nd to smallest of the layering ovals dies, trace the oval on the top of the folded paper.



6. Using your paper snip, cut along the tracing thru all layers of the paper.



7. Unfold the paper to reveal the flower.



8. Clip away one petal with your paper snips.



9. Add liquid glue to one of the petals.



10. Overlap petals to close the hole.



11. Fold flower in half.



12. Repeat steps until you have 7 flowers.



13. Add liquid adhesive to the outside petals on flower 1 and adhere flower 2 and 3.



14. Add liquid adhesive to the center 3 petals and adhere flower 4.



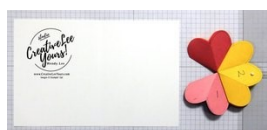
15. Add liquid adhesive to two petals on the left side and adhere flower 5.



16. Add liquid adhesive to two petals on the right side and adhere flower 6.



17. Add liquid adhesive to the center 3 petals and adhere flower 7.



18. Add liquid adhesive to the center top petal and adhere the flower to the inside of the card base. Be sure the petals do not hang over the edge and are just a bit away from the center fold line.



19. Add liquid adhesive to the top center petal on the other side of the flower and close the card front. Let adhesive dry.



20. When you open the card you get a beautiful pop up bouquet.
