



## Project Recipe:

	<p>1. Score 10" x 4-1/4" pretty peacock cardstock at 1-3/4" &amp; 4-1/2" for card base.</p>
	<p>2. Using a 1-1/2" Circle punch, cut out a partial circle from the narrow tab of the card base.</p> <p>Apply Tear &amp; Tape to the top &amp; bottom of the tab.</p> <p>Tip: place tape close to the cut edges to leave plenty of room for the gift card to slide into the pocket.</p>
	<p>3. Remove backing paper from tape and fold along score line to create pocket.</p>
	<p>4. Die-cut bow from center of 2-1/2" x 4" Copper Foil layer with Stitched Be Mine dies.</p> <p>Keep both pieces.</p>



5. Adhere 2-3/8" x 3-7/8" DSP to 2-1/2" x 4" Copper Foil with SNAIL adhesive.

You will need 2 sets.



6. Fold card base along 4-1/2" score line to close card.

Adhere layers to left front card base with dimensionals.

Adhere layers to right front card base with SNAIL adhesive.



7. Wrap (2) pieces of approx. 4" ribbon around 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" Pretty Peacock foil, adhering ends to back of layer with SNAIL adhesive.

Loop approx. 6" thread around ribbon and thru hole in die-cut bow and tie in a bow to cinch the ribbon and secure to die-cut.



8. Using the 1-1/8" Scallop Circle punch, cut out from 3" x 3" Copper Foil layer.

Keep both layers.



9. Adhere foil layers together with SNAIL adhesive.

Adhere layers to left side of card front with SNAIL adhesive.



10. Using the 1" Circle punch, cut out from scrap of DSP.

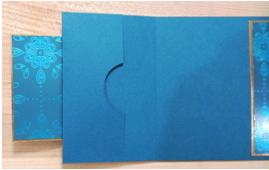


11. Adhere punched circles together with SNAIL adhesive.

Position circles so they catch the outer edge of the present and adhere to card front with dimensionals. Be sure dimensionals are placed so they are not adhered to the present or the card will not open.



12. Using the Take Your Pick tool, apply star to card front.



13. Adhere 1-3/8" x 2-7/8" DSP to 1-1/2" x 3" Copper Foil with SNAIL adhesive.

Adhere to back of present to cover the exposed white backside of the layers.



14. Stamp snowflakes from the October 2019 Paper Pumpkin kit stamp set in Pretty Peacock ink on 2-1/2" x 4" Very Vanilla cardstock.

Stamp sentiment in Copper ink.

Adhere layer to card inside with SNAIL adhesive.
