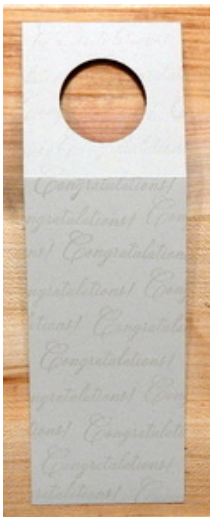
## Cheers To The Bride & Groom Bottle Tag



Supplies needed:

- Cheers To That Bundle [153048]
- Cheers To That Cling Stamp Set (En) [150557]
- Sahara Sand 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [121043]
- Seaside Spray 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [150883]
- Terracotta Tile 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [150884]
- Vellum 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [101856]
- Woven Threads Designer Series Paper [149497]
- Pearlized Doilies [146936]
- Versamark Pad [102283]
- White Stampin' Emboss Powder [109132]
- Woven Threads Sequin Assortment [149498]
- Embossing Buddy [103083]
- Heat Tool (Us And Canada) [129053]
- 1-1/2" (3.8 Cm) Circle Punch [138299]
- Cheers Dies [150669]
- Sip & Celebrate Dies [150668]

## Project Recipe:



1. Score 2-3/4" x 8-1/2" Sarah Sand cardstock at 2-3/4".

Using the 1-1/2" circle punch, cut hole in center of smaller section. This will be the top of your tag.

Stamp sentiment all over layer with Versamark ink.



2. Adhere 2" x 5-3/4" to larger section of tag with SNAIL adhesive.



3. Adhere doily to tag front with SNAIL adhesive.



4. Die-cut (2) glasses from 1-1/4" x 7-1/2" Seaside Spray cardstock with Sip & Celebrate dies.

Using a masking technique, ink up portion of sentiment and stamp on each glass with Versamark ink. Heat Emboss with White powder.

Adhere glasses to tag front with dimensionals.



5. Die-cut 4" x 2" Terracotta Tile cardstock with Cheers dies.

Adhere die-cut to 3-7/8" x 3/4" Vellum with fine tip glue.

Banner cut ends of Vellum with paper snips.

Adhere banner to tag front with glue dots. Tip: place glue dots so they fall behind the die-cut so the adhesive does not show thru the vellum.



6. Using the Take Your Pick tool, adhere sequins to tag front with fine tip glue.
