## Easter Blessings Treat Holder

## Supplies needed:

- Itty Bitty Greetings Cling-Mount Stamp Set [151331]
- Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock [100730]
- Peaceful Poppies Designer Series Paper [151324]
- Poppy Parade Classic Stampin' Pad [147050]
- Whisper White 5/8" (1.6 Cm) Polka Dot Tulle Ribbon [146912]
- Classic Label Punch [141491]
- Paper Trimmer [152392]
- Paper Snips [103579]
- Bone Folder [102300]
- Snail Adhesive [104332]
- Mini Glue Dots [103683]

## Project Recipe:



1. Score (2) 1-1/4" x 7-3/4" strips of DSP at 1-1/4" and 5-1/4".

Fold along each score line, running bone folder along folded edges for a nice crisp fold.

This will be the treat holder.



2. Run bone folder along each strip to add a bit of curve.

Adhere the top of the two strips together (approx 3/4" deep) with SNAIL adhesive.



3. Adhere the bottom of the two strips together, overlapping the 1-1/4" tabs, with SNAIL adhesive.



4. Tie approx. 14" ribbon around center of strips, cinching in the center, into a bow.



5. Wrap 1-1/4" x 3-1/2" DSP around candy (I used Hersey nuggets), adhering ends together along bottom of candy with SNAIL adhesive. The paper will stand away from the candy along the top side.



6. Adhere candy to bottom of inside of treat holder.



7. Stamp sentiment from Itty Bitty Greetings stamp set on scrap of Whisper White cardstock with Poppy Parade ink.

Cut out with Classic Label punch. Punch one end a second time with the punch to banner cut the end.



8. Adhere pointed end of sentiment to treat base, just under ribbon, with glue dot.
