## Contour Flowers



### Supplies needed:

- Color & Contour Bundle (English) [158356]
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Thick Cardstock [159229]
- Basic White 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [159276]
- Fresh Freesia 8 1/2" X 11" Cardstock [155613]
- 2021–2023 In Color 6" X 6" (15.2 X 15.2 Cm) Designer Series Paper [155641]
- Fresh Freesia Classic Stampin' Pad [155611]
- Soft Succulent Stampin' Blends Combo Pack [155521]
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708]
- Fresh Freesia 3/8" (1 Cm) Open Weave Ribbon [155615]
- Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653]
- Paper Trimmer [152392]
- Paper Snips [103579]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]
- Mini Glue Dots [103683]

### Project Recipe:

1. Fold 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" Thick Basic White cardstock in half for card base.
2. Die cut 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" Fresh Freesia cardstock with largest rectangle from Scallop Contour Dies. Adhere to card front with dimensionals.

3. Adhere (2) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" DSP pieces to card front with Stampin' Seal.
4. Stamp the floral image in Memento black and the flower fill images with Fresh Freesia on 2-1/2" x 3-3/4" Basic White cardstock. Add a swipe of Soft Succulent with Stampin' Blends to add a little splash of green to the leaves and stem.
5. Tie approx. 9" of ribbon into a bow and adhere to card front with glue dot.
6. Stamp the floral image in Memento black and the flower fill images with Fresh Freesia on card inside. Add a swipe of Soft Succulent with Stampin' Blends to add a little splash of green to the leaves.
